The Michigan had her maiden voyage on April 29, 1982, and is the most famous large cruise ship on Lake Biwa. She is named after the American state of Michigan, which has a sister state relationship with Shiga Prefecture, as a wish for friendly relations between the two countries. Since her first voyage, she has been beloved by millions of passengers as the only stern-wheeler in Japan.



The Michigan is unusual in that it is a stern-wheeler, powered by a single rear paddle wheel. Passengers can get a view of the wheel from directly above in the Paddle Watching Zone.







### Main Hall, Hogon-ji (Benzaiten Hall)

This hall houses the Benzaiten image. Don't miss the paintings of the Heavenly Deities and the Flying Angels.



#### **Boat Corridor**, Hogon-ji (Important Cultural Property)

Said to have been built using the hull from Tovotomi Hidevoshi's pleasure craft. Nipponmaru. (Approx. 1.8 m wide, 30 m long)

Karamon Gate (National Treasure) Kannon-do Hall, Hogon-ji Part of the sixteenth-century "Paradise Bridge" in Toyotomi Hideyoshi's Osaka Castle, this is the only remaining part of the castle. The arched gable gate is a classic example of Momoyama-period design. The Kannon-do Hall houses a statue of the

Many fascinating shops can be found in this area, including the old bank building that had been known by its nickname of the "Kurokabe (Black Wall) Bank" from the Meiji period, and has now been renovated as the Kurokabe Glass Shop.


