

About six kilometers off the shore of Lake Biwa is a granite island about two kilometers in circumference. The island is known for "Sinking Shadow of Chikubushima" in the famous Eight Views of Lake Biwa. A popular "power spot," the entire island is steeped in a mystical atmosphere, and people come from all over the country to visit. The Benten Daruma Dolls of Happiness at the Hogon-ji Temple and the "kawarake-nage" clay dish-throwing at the Tsukubusuma Shrine are both popular ways to help make prayers come true.


